ESA Section 9 – Prohibited Acts

"Take" means to harass, harm, pursue, hunt, shoot, wound, kill, trap, capture, or collect - or to attempt to engage in any such conduct.









ESA Section 7 and Section 10

Incidental take of listed species can be authorized under ESA Sections 7(a)(2) and 10(a)(1)(B).

Service can recommend:

 mitigation to offset adverse impacts of incidental take actions under section 7(a)(2)

Service can require:

 mitigation under section 7 jeopardy/adverse modification determination and under section 10

Section 7(a)(1) – develop conservation plans that include compensatory mitigation programs





Section 7(a)(2) and Compensatory Mitigation



1. Incorporated into the Proposed Action (Conservation Measures) to mitigate unavoidable negative effects of the proposed action

Mandatory

As Conservation Recommendations
 to avoid, minimize, or mitigate adverse effects on listed species or
 critical habitat

Discretionary

3. As a Reasonable and Prudent Alternative (RPA) to avoid likelihood of jeopardizing continued existence of a listed species or destruction or adverse modification of critical habitat

Mandatory



Proposed ESA Implementing Reg. Changes


§402.14: Formal Consultation

- Reasonable and Prudent Measures (RPMs) may include offsets (mitigation)
- Offsets may occur within or outside of the action area
- As with any RPM, continue to be subject to the minor change rule




